**Supply of Road Construction and Maintenance Equipment AWF/NFA RFQ No. 001**

The African Wildlife Foundation (“AWF”) is an international non-governmental organization headquartered in Nairobi, Kenya, and with offices in Uganda at Palm Courts, Plot 7A, Lugogo Bypass, P. O. Box 37346 Kampala. AWF is implementing the USAID/Uganda Biodiversity Program aimed at achieving sustainable biodiversity conservation and local economic growth in five priority protected areas in Uganda. Two of the protected areas are managed by National Forestry Authority (NFA) and they are Budongo and Kalinzu Central Forest Reserves.

Part of the funding from USAID under the Uganda Biodiversity Program has been set aside to support NFA acquire road equipment for use in improving protected area road infrastructure for monitoring and natural resource management. AWF is supporting NFA in the procurement of road construction and maintenance equipment which include one excavator, one self-loading truck (flatbed truck), one vibrator roller and one grader.

African Wildlife Foundation (AWF) hereby invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for the provision of the above equipment.

Interested eligible bidders may obtain further information and inspect the bidding documents at USAID/Uganda Biodiversity Program and African Wildlife Foundation Offices between 9.00 am and 3.00 pm daily before the closing date.
